1:05pm- Guest Presentation: "Monitoring Waterbodies through Spatially Balanced Surveys: National, State, and Local Perspectives"

- Description: This webinar panel includes Hugh Sullivan, from EPA's Office of Wetlands, Oceans, and Watersheds, speaking on the National Coastal Condition Assessment, and Jay Silvanima, from Florida Department of Environmental Protection, presenting on that agency's design, implementation, and analysis of waterbodies using spatially balanced probabilistic surveys, and Mike McManus, from EPA's Office of Research and Development. Mike's presentation is on "Aquatic Surveys, Open Science & Participatory Science". His focus is on the local perspective as he will be using EPA's [Survey Design Tool](#) to compare a survey based on independent random sample (IRS) design to a spatially balanced probabilistic design. The later design gives a better geographic distribution of survey sites compared to an IRS design. Also, the spatially balanced survey tends





to give more precise estimates than an IRS survey. He will use the tool to design a survey of a local estuary.
